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SB 563 Utilization Review	 Proposed legislation which: Requires that the method of compensation, and any incentive payments, contingent upon the approval, modification or denial of a claim, for an individual or entity providing services pursuant to the utilization review process, be filed with the administrative director and disclosed by the employer upon request. Exempts a request from the utilization process by a physician for an injured worker for specified, evidence-based, future medical treatment pursuant to a final award of permanent disability. Establishes a provision for an employer to challenge such an exemption to the utilization review process, if the employer believes the medical treatment request is not evidence based. Cases 910 (significant panel decision) Nurse Case Manager Services	 The California Workers' Compensation Appeals Board (WCAB) issued an opinion and decision after reconsideration, which held that: The provision of a nurse case manager is a form of medical treatment under the Labor Code. An employer may not unilaterally cease to provide approved nurse case manager services when there is no evidence of a change in the employee's circumstances or condition showing that the services are no longer reasonably required to cure or relieve the worker from the effects of the industrial injury. It is not necessary for an injured worker to obtain a request for authorization to challenge the unilateral termination of the services of a nurse case manager. Dubon v. World Restoration Inc, (2014) (Appeals Board en banc) 79 Cal. Comp. Cases 1298 Utilization Review	 The California Workers' Compensation Appeals Board ("WCAB") issued an en banc opinion, rescinding the February 27, 2014 opinion, and affirming the September 20, 2013 findings and order of the administrative law judge, as amended on October 18, 2013, and held: A utilization review ("UR") decision is invalid and not subject to independent medical review ("IMR") only if it is untimely. Legal issues regarding the timeliness of a UR decision must be resolved by the WCAB, not IMR. All other disputes regarding a UR decision must be resolved by IMR. If the UR decision is untimely, the determination of medical necessity may be made by the WCAB based on substantial medical evidence consistent with Labor Code section 4604.5. A NCM should not express opinions, to either the injured worker or the medical provider, regarding an injured worker's course of medical care or otherwise attempt to influence the process. Medical Treatment Dispute Reviews	 The 19th District Court in Baton Rouge declared on 6/24/15 that the state's process for the administrative adjudication of a worker's request for medical treatment is unconstitutional, and issued a preliminary injunction barring the Louisiana Workforce Commission, Office of Workers' Compensation, from enforcing the regulatory scheme for injured workers seeking approval of treatment requests. The Court stayed enforcement of the preliminary injunction, pending an appeal, on 8/6/15.
