


Steps for Reporting an Injury

INJURED EMPLOYEE:

- 1. Immediately report the injury to your supervisor or your human resources personnel.
- Seek medical treatment at the nearest occupational health clinic. For a list
 of providers, visit the website www.aig.com/intellirisk. To search for a
 provider:
 - Click on "Find Medical Care" and then the link "Find nearby medical care."
 - Do a radius search, and under the Provider Types, select "First Treatment Providers."
 - To narrow your search, choose "Occupational/Industrial Medicine."
- Your supervisor or human resources personnel will give you a Tmesys
 Pharmacy First Fill document. Take this document with you to a medical
 facility as well as the pharmacy information, if you are given a script for
 your work-related injury.
- 4. Let your supervisor or human resources personnel know when you have received medical treatment, and the results of the visit (i.e., work restrictions or full duty).

EMPLOYER:

- 1. Report the injury immediately to AIG via "Report a Claim" at www.aig.com/reportaclaim or telephonically at 800-910-2667.
- Direct employee to the nearest occupational health clinic and provide them with information on the pharmacy benefits management. For a list of providers, visit the website www.aig.com/intellirisk. See search instructions under the Injured Employee section.





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
